SAFEHOME

SAFEHOME provides a healing atmosphere where survivors of domestic violence can receive respite, gain inner strength, build self-esteem, explore options and establish a life free of violence. In addition to providing shelter in a safe environment, SAFEHOME's services include individual and group counseling for women and children, advocacy in court cases and assistance with housing, vocation, child care, and school challenges. Additionally, SAFEHOME provides a milieu of services to the community at large. These services include a confidential 24-hour crisis hotline (913-262-2868), individual, family and children's counseling and support groups, 24-hour on-call advocacy for victims in hospitals, training for medical staff, on-site referrals to SRS, information and advocacy during hearings and trials, assistance in obtaining Protection From Abuse and Emergency Protection court orders, and extensive educational presentations to schools, businesses and various community organizations. All SAFEHOME services are confidential and free.

OZANAM

Since 1948, Ozanam has helped thousands of children with emotional, behavioral and learning disabilities by providing residential and day treatment programs for boys and girls ages 12-18 on its main campus in south Kansas City. Also, through its Pathways Transitional Living Program, Ozanam provides shelter, counseling support and job training to young adults who are at risk of becoming homeless in Kansas City and Wichita. Ozanam also provides educational services to community school districts by offering educational consultation programs through our Behavior Intervention Support Team (BIST) to more than 300 schools throughout the Midwest. Ozanam provides services to more than 225 at-risk children each day and additionally impacts thousands of students each day through our BIST program.

THE PLAZA ROTARY FOUNDATION

The Kansas City Plaza Rotary Charitable Foundation was formed in 1992 and enjoys 501(c) (3) status under the Internal Revenue Code. The mission of the Foundation is to promote community betterment through the support of youth, education and the elderly. The Foundation Board is made up of the past presidents of the Plaza Rotary Club. Since the inception, the Foundation has disbursed thousands of dollars raised through the efforts of the members of the Plaza Rotary Club. Under the current policy, seventy-five percent of the net proceeds of the Jazz Cabaret are awarded to the primary and the secondary beneficiaries.
